Transition with a rhetorical question (obviously must lead to the following topic)

2nd to last PP: Use an anaphora

Transitions to conclusion with a parallel sentence structure., an isocolon would be best. This will aide in you not having to repeat all key points in the conclusion, and allow you more access to extend the ideas of the paper beyond the text into a modern, real-world application (a rationale for your papers importance, today, right now).
